Guidelines & Information

1. The movie will be shown at the Holy Family Center and will be available to St. Patrick Students ONLY. Any SPH student in grades PreK thru 8th are welcome to attend.
2. Students may bring pillows and sleeping bags to lie on during the movie.
3. Donation of \$5 per student (maximum \$10 per family) must be sent in with registration form.
4. A drink and treat will be provided at intermission. The cost of this is covered in the donation amount. **FOOD AND DRINK FROM HOME IS NOT PERMITTED.**
5. The reservation form must be filled out completely and returned by the date specified. Only Students with a reservation will be allowed to attend.
6. Please be prompt in dropping off and picking up your student. We are all volunteers and want to leave on time. Parents will be required to pick up their students at the Holy Family Center.
7. Emergency numbers are mandatory. In the event of illness or misconduct, we must be able to reach a parent or guardian. Students are expected to display good behavior so others may enjoy the movie. If disruptive behavior is a problem, the parent will be contacted and the student may be given restrictions on attending any future Movie Night.
8. Some movies we select may be rated PG. Please take a moment to consider whether the movie is appropriate for your student. Although we have tried to select a movie that would appeal to all St. Patrick students, the final decision lies with you, the parent.
